<u>Cemetery Charges / Regulations for Lavendon Parish Cemetery and Garden of Remembrance</u>

At its meeting held on 12th January 2024, Lavendon Parish Council agreed to an increase in cemetery fees for the first time in almost twelve years. The cemetery fees will increase from 1st February 2024 as follows:-

Burial/Grant of exclusive right of burial:

	FEE PAYABLE
Burial in single depth earth grave to a depth not exceeding 2m to include	£425.00
Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial	
Burial in earth grave, extra depth, to include Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial	£500.00
Children	£100.00
Burial of a child under the age of 12 at death	
Any subsequent burial in the same grave	£168.00
Interment of ashes in an existing grave	£67.00
Interment of ashes in new cremation plot, to include Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial	£200.00

Monuments:

Permission must be sought to erect a monument and/or to make an additional inscription to same. Permission will be granted subject to being of an approved type, as follows:-

For grave in cemetery, Maximum dimensions, Height, 2'6", Width 2', Depth, 12"; For cremation plot, cemetery, Maximum dimensions, Height, 2', Width, 16". For ashes in Garden of Remembrance, Maximum dimensions, 18" by 12", placed horizontally. An additional inscription to be added to an existing monument.

Fee to erect a monument to the above specification

A recommended 6 months from burial to placement of memorial is recommended to allow ground settlement

- 1. Where the individual making an application for burial dies in a care home, where they had been resident in the village prior to this, they will still be considered a resident.
- 2. Where the individual making an application for burial is not resident in the village, nor has significant ties with the village, the application will be refused.
- 3. Where the individual making an application for burial is not resident in the village, but does have significant ties with the village; this will be considered by the council, and if agreed the fees will be doubled.
