**11. Ward Councillors Report** – Keith thanked Ann for highlighting the incorrect bus timetable, this should be changed soon. DRT still has problems with the phone-in service but the app is working well.

Child poverty was mentioned last meeting and Keith thanked Steve for highlighting that we were unaware of it, they are looking at ways to offer to a lot more people by inviting councillors to participate via zoom.

The elections secured the conservatives 24 places in MKC, a majority of 29 is required so they will be discussing working together with other parties and will have an update by next meeting.

The EW expressway has halted, the railway is going ahead with major works in progress at Bletchley, the housing is unknown, it's hoped to know a bit more soon.

Moving of the War Memorial was discussed, worry for the safety of residents during the Remembrance Day service and for the structure itself being in a very vulnerable position.

Concern for the house at 6 Northampton Road as Highways have not upheld their complaint for the repair that was badly done. Keith is on the case.
