- 4. **Public Question Time** none present
- 5. Ward Councillors Report The Ward Councillors will be speaking against the housing infrastructure bid to put another bridge over the M1 to allow the development at Moulsoe, it will likely go near Willen and will probably proceed. Plan:MK goes to public examination 10th July and again in August, the plan looks sound. A new head of Highways has been appointed on a permanent role. Gas leaks have been reported in Olney Road, hence the road markings. A new National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) is coming in, the sooner we get it the sooner we have security. The East West corridor has two possible routes, the expectation is that Highways England will decide where in the next few weeks, we'll know more in September; it is a 50 year project.
