Minutes of the Monthly meeting of Lavendon Parish Council held on Monday 13th March 2017

1. The Chairman welcomed those present, apologies for absence were noted from Mr A Tourle and Cllr D Hosking.
2. **The minutes of the Monthly Meeting** of 13th February were confirmed and signed.
3. **Declaration of Interests on Agenda Items** – none.
4. **Public Question Time** – no public present
5. **Ward Councillors Report** – If agreed, green bins will cost £33pa or £16.50 for 6 months starting September or a 3gal caddy for food waste only will be supplied FOC.

Minerals Plan, awaiting what consultation will bring.
Clean MK use community groups to work with the council to clean the parishes & laybys. MKC should take on cleaning outside villages but maybe not within. CCTV in laybys is possible where litter is bad.
MR asked about the legalities of drones, contact police or Mark Lancaster.
PG recommended that a car park be built by residents of New Row as owner agreed to sell.
6. **Finance Report** –
 - a. Payments and receipts during February 2017 were presented and approved.
 - b. Purchases for approval – JB to investigate the price of paving slabs, rubber matting or grass crete to be put in place of the chippings around the pavilion.

7. **a. Landscaping** – The fly tipping in the brook at Jacks Close has been reported to MKC (14.3.17 MKC reported the works complete).
Road signs need cleaning, JB to instruct CP team.
Allotment hedge on road side needs trimming, JB to instruct Martin.
b. Planning – Neighbourhood plan meeting with Sherington PC arranged for next week.

- c. **Cemetery** – Martin has completed extensive tree works, CP team has cleared it all.

- f. **The Old School** – roof repairs have been completed.
